

About the Director of Tax Equalization

The Office of the Director of Tax Equalization was established in 1978 and the position is appointed by the County Commission. The Tax Director is responsible for training and helping the local Assessors in establishing and maintaining fair and proper assessments on locally assessed properties as well as advising the County Commission on property tax issues. This office administers the assessment and collection of mobile home taxes. Currently a G.I.S. (Geographic Information System) is being implemented by this office for future use in agricultural land assessments.
