Wells County Commissioner's Meeting Minutes July 8, 2025

The July meeting was called to order by Chairman Dockter at 8:10 AM. Present at the meeting were Stan Buxa, Dennis Dockter, Bryan Lautt, Danny Maxwell, Brian Miller, Jackie Bauerle, Ivy Brye, Lydia Gessele, Gene Hartl, Blake Liss, Wells McGiffert, Jana Mogren, Alex Molander, Annette Sprague, Steven Sprague, Dakota Steedsman, Daniel Stutlien, and Neil Nelson of the Herald-Press.

BM (M), SB (S) to approve the minutes from the June Meeting. Unanimously carried.

BL (M), DM (S) to approve the minutes from the June Annual Equalization Meeting. Unanimously carried.

Employee timesheets were reviewed by the commissioners.

DM (M), BL (S) to approve the bills as presented. Unanimously carried.

The current WC Balance Sheet was reviewed and discussed. Also, the Auditor shared current county investments as well as Commission controlled WC funds. BM (M), DM (S) to approve the Balance Sheet. Unanimously carried.

Pledged Securities for all WC bank accounts were reviewed by the Commission. It was the consensus of the Commission the securities were adequate to cover the county's current deposits.

SB (M), BL (S) to approve Laura Muscha, Treasurer, and Daniel Stutlien, Auditor, to purchase or cash out CD's and investments on behalf of WC. Unanimously carried.

Correspondence from Garrison Diversion regarding their matching recreation grant program was shared with the Commission and has been sent to the seven cities in WC. Also shared was notice of a property transfer of the old Sykeston Rest Area to a nearby patron and notice from ND Water Resources of WC being re-mapped for flood risk accuracy.

Commission Portfolios were reviewed and discussed.

WC Clerk of Court, Carla Johnson, addressed the Commission regarding the duties and responsibilities of her office. Johnson provided a handout summing up the main responsibilities of the C of C's office working jointly with law enforcement, the States Attorney, the court system, and a multitude of other agencies.

Anne Ehni from the WC Soil Conservation District was slated to address the Commission, but was unable to attend. Ehni will be rescheduled for a subsequent meeting.

Steven Sprague of Fram Township visited with the Commission. Sprague began with appreciation for both the Commission and the Planning & Zoning Committee. Sprague encouraged the Commission to pass the ordinance as recommended by the P & Z Committee.

Wells McGiffert of PRC Wind spoke with the Commission regarding the Wind Ordinance. McGiffert also thanked both the Commission & the P&Z Committee and suggested PRC also supports the passage of the ordinance with some minor recommended alteration to clear up language.

WC Road Foreman, Brent Keller, met with the Commission to discuss matters of his Dept. Keller discussed present personnel and lack of applicants for open positions in the shop. Keller also discussed current and upcoming projects for the Dept. Keller also brought in Janelle Pepple to discuss street sign along county roads. SB (M), BL (S) to replace all street signs along county roads. Unanimously carried.

Jason Mayfield of Wold Engineering sat down with the Commission and talked about the Flexible Transportation Fund Program and the scoring matrixes for grant success. Mayfield also discussed bridge scour and bridge condition in WC. The Commission reiterated priorities of WC #1 and Old 52. The Hamberg Slough Project appears to be an after Labor Day project.

Two beer & liquor license extensions were requested from Flatland Trailblazers and the Fessenden Country Club, dba Festival Hall. BM (*M*), SB (*S*) to approve Fessenden Country Club request for Saturday, July 12th. Unanimously carried. BM (*M*), DM (*S*) to approve Flatland's request for Sunday, July 13th. Unanimously carried.

An estimate from Fargo Glass & Paint to replace the entrance doors at Festival Hall. The estimate for the front doors is \$15,893.00. The estimate for the back doors is \$9,863.00. An additional estimate of \$3,673.00 would be required to install accessibility openers in the front of the building. DM (M), BL (S) to approve funding for the front door and accessibility options. Unanimously carried.

The Commission considered selling parcel #45104000 now that it is cleaned up. The property had originally been home to the Cathay School. SB (*M*), DM (*S*) to approve the sale of the property to the City of Cathay for \$1. Unanimously carried.

A letter of resignation from Janelle Pepple was considered for her role as the manager of Festival Hall effective 12/31/25. SB (*M*), BM (*S*) to approve Pepple's resignation and thank her many years of management of the facility. Unanimously carried. This role will likely be absorbed in the Auditor's office.

WC Auditor, Daniel Stutlien, begin leading the Commission through the '26 budget requests of each WC department. Regarding potential employee salary and benefits, Stutlien apprised the Commission the '26 health insurance increase will be 9.1%. The Commission directed the Auditor to maintain the 2% along with \$800 and \$400 in equity payments. The Commission will plan to hold a special meeting later in July to examine the entire budget prior to and look at funding specifically considering the new caps.

In Planning & Zoning, the Commission considered a variance request from Mike Alveshere to place a new house where his existing house is. SB (*M*), DM (*S*) to approve Alveshere's variance request. Unanimously carried. The Commission was also asked to consider the new Wind Ordinance as submitted by the Planning & Zoning Committee with alterations regarding primary residence definition, blade clearance height, collector and feeder line placement, permit fees, and a setback of 1 mile w/ variance options as discussed. SB (*M*), DM (*S*) to approve the new ordinance as presented with modifications. Unanimously carried.

Consideration of a new policy regarding public commenting at regular meetings of the WC Commission was undertaken. This is required to become a standard part of each regular meeting of the Commission beginning in August. Requests to address the Commission will need to be made in advance of the meeting and must not only adhere to agenda items, but must also follow public decorum rules and adhere to other minimum guidance. BM (M), BL (S) to approve the new policy for public comments. Unanimously carried. The newly adopted policy will be

available at regular meetings and may also be obtained from the WC Auditor's Office at any time.

A special meeting of the WC Commission to examine the '26 budget will be held Tuesday, July 29th, at 8:00 AM. The regular August WC Commission Meeting will be Tuesday, August 5th, 2025 at 8:00 AM.

The next Departments Meeting will be held Thursday, July 17th, at 1:00 PM in the KTL Building.

The next Six-County Meeting will be held Tuesday, September 9th, in Emmons Co. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:56 AM.
